

ROUTINE

DRILL -CIC
Monday night**5 MINUTES BEFORE NET:**

This is K6CPT Station "A". A net will be conducted on this frequency in five minutes. The cooperation of all amateurs on this frequency for the duration of a test drill to commence at nineteen hundred hours will be greatly appreciated. This is K6CPT Station "A", (unit I.D.), clear.

OPENING NET:

This is K6CPT Station "A", net control station of the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service.

This net is activated at nineteen hundred hours. This is a directed closed net for Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service and only registered members may be recognized by this net control station.

Members operating from a County or City Station shall identify with "K6CPT" and the Station identifier. Members operating from their own station will use their unit identifier followed by their amateur call. This operator is (unit I.D.)

Procedure:

1. Announce which bands will be activated for the net.
2. Transmit messages (copy speed on 220 band, reading speed all others).
3. Roll call of district stations, (list any traffic).
4. Call for missed district stations.
5. Call for city EOC stations in non-active districts.
6. Call for support EOC X-ray stations.

FOR 2 METER OPERATOR ONLY**6a. Read "preamble for the Fire Department Net"**

The Disaster Communications Service will be conducting a brief net for the Los Angeles County Fire Department on this frequency. Fire command, X-RAY 9, will be the net control station until control is passed back to this station. Following the fire department net this station will be continuing a disaster preparedness net until twenty hundred hours X-RAY 9, this is Station "A", K6CPT.

6b. After the fire net is completed, X-RAY 9 returns the net to Station "A".

7. Call for Staff Officer check-ins.
8. Call for Zebra Operator check-ins.
9. Call for members unable to check in with their DIC's.
10. Call for missed check-ins.
11. Station "A" will stand by until twenty hundred hours. K6CPT

5 MINUTES BEFORE NET:

This is K6CPT Station "A". A net will be conducted on this frequency in five minutes. The cooperation of all amateurs on this frequency for the duration of a test drill to commence at eleven thirty hours will be greatly appreciated. This is K6CPT Station "A", (unit I.D.), clear

OPENING NET:

This is K6CPT Station "A", net control station of the Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service.

This net is activated at eleven thirty hours. This is a directed closed net for Los Angeles County Disaster Communications Service and only registered members may be recognized by this net control station.

However, as time permits the net will be open to non-member seeking information about Disaster Communications following check-ins.

Members operating from a County or City Station shall identify with "K6CPT" and the Station identifier. Members operating from their own station will use their unit identifier followed by their amateur call. This operator is (unit I.D.)

Procedure:

1. Transmit messages
2. Roll call of district stations
3. Call for Staff Officer check-ins
4. Call for Zebra Operator check-ins
5. Call for missed stations
6. Call for anyone with questions regarding Disaster Communications
7. Call for guest check-ins

Repeat procedures as time permits.
